

Geography Term 3 Study Guide

On the unit test, you can expect to have not less than one essay question, not less than 4 short answer questions, and identification/matching/multiple choice/fill in the blank questions to total 100 points.

For the test for Term 3, you should be able to answer multiple choice and matching questions. You should also be able to take knowledge you have gained in class and apply it in situations similar to those used as examples in class.

Additionally, specific topics include:

- The hydrological cycle and how it applies to rivers, flood plains, and climate change
- Land form formation through river actions
- causes of flooding, ways communities work to alleviate the risks and damage from flooding.

You will not be able to use notes or other materials on your test.

You will have at least one question requiring an essay-style response, written in complete sentences and paragraph form. You will also have at least 4 short-answer questions which must be written in complete sentences.
